## RE DELEGATION OF QUALITY ASSURANCE FUNCTIONS FOR CURRENTLY REGISTERED NQF QUALIFICATIONS PROFESSIONAL BODIES

In terms of Section 32 of the NQF Act 67 of 2008 read with section 26I of the SDA (2) 37 of 2008, SAQA and the Quality Councils (QCs) have the power to delegate any of their functions to a committee, any other body capable of performing the function or an employee.

The Council agreed to delegate certain quality assurance functions to professional bodies. This delegation will be governed by terms of conditions which form part of the delegation.

It must be noted that should a quality assuring body find itself unable to perform its delegated functions, the QCTO will be left with no other recourse than to find a replacement for which the quality assurance body will have to assume the financial responsibility. This process is in line with the procedure used where a training provider fails to execute its functions, but remains accountable for ensuring service delivery.

Attached is the delegation terms of conditions from the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) to your SETA.
